NBP'S ANOTHER STEP FOR FLOOD AFFECTED PEOPLE

September 8, 2010: After successful arrangement of Medical Relief Camp for flood affected people at Razzakabad, NBP in collaboration with People's Doctors Forum has established another Medical Relief Camp for Flood Affected People at Pipri, Karachi. Specialists and consultant doctors of skin, gynea, eye, neuro and other specialists were attending the patients. Thousands of flood affectees were given free consultation by doctors and free treatment and free medicines were distributed. From National Bank of Pakistan, Mr. Imam Bakhsh Baloch, SEVP/Group Chief, Audit & Inspection along with Mr. Shahab Kazi, Head of Media Marketing & PR visited the camp and praised the efforts of doctors, People's Doctors Forum, and volunteers of NBP who made this medical camp a success and announced that NBP will arrange and organize these types of medical camps in other affected areas of Pakistan as well.
