NBP PROVIDES RS.60 MILLION FOOD TO 40,000 FLOOD AFFECTED FAMILIES

Karachi: To mitigate sufferings of the people affected by recent massive floods, the management of the National Bank of Pakistan, besides contributing Rs.50 million to the Prime Minister's Flood Relief Fund-2010 and Rs.10 million to the Bakhtawar Flood Relief Fund, has decided to reach out to the flood affectees and provide them relief goods (eatables) in bags at an approximate cost of Rs.60 million.

The Bank has planned to initially distribute 40,000 such bags across the regions in the affected areas. Each bag will contain eatables for a family of about six persons and will suffice their requirements for approximately one week.

For distribution of these relief goods, Bank's regional management teams will seek assistance of the local administration and armed forces personnel engaged in the relief work in the relevant areas.

Management and employees of the Bank also urge the corporate sector and civil society to rise to this occasion of national calamity.
