Karachi: This is with reference to news item published in certain section of print media where in it is stated that some persons are observing hunger strike at Hyderabad Press Club for enforcement of their right on induction in National Bank of Pakistan.

It is clarified that National Bank of Pakistan has already regularized services of more than 50 (fifty) daily wagers, Godown Keepers, GodownChowkedars and others who had fulfilled the criteria stipulated for regularization of their services as per Bank policy.

The case of above mentioned hunger strikes have already been thoroughly examined by the management in the light of the policy. After investigation, it has transpired that they do not fulfill the criteria for induction. Hence their demands are without merit.

The Hon'able Sindh High Court Hyderabad Bench has already dismissed their petition vide its judgment order dated March 01, 2012 and they have filed a review application against the said judgment.

Therefore the matter is subjudice before the Hon'able Sindh High Court Hyderabad Court. National Bank of Pakistan being a good corporate citizen always strictly follow it's policies formulated at the competent level and it can't think of depriving anybody from its due right.
