**NBP Receives Rs. 274 Million from Pakistan Railways
Disbursement of Pension Continues Smoothly**

Karachi October 27, 2011: National Bank of Pakistan today (27.10.2011) received Rs. 274 million from Pakistan Railways after which disbursement of pension to PR pensioners in Lahore continued smoothly. Yesterday NBP staff worked continuously for 16 hours and ensured that each and every pensioner present in the branch should be entertained.
